- 3 Pray for the special group meetings in Meru this week with professionals, leaders, students and women, for God to touch each group with the Gospel.
- 4 Thank God for those churches and individuals who have been faithful in giving to the ministry! Pray for the blessing of the Lord to be upon them.
- 5 Pray even in these final hours that God would continue to provide necessary funds and resources for this mission!
- 6 Pray for good relations with the local pastors in Meru through the work of the mission.
- 7 Pray for the street evangelists to be drawn by the Spirit to those who most need Christ's love.
- 8 On this last day of the Meru Mission, pray for the closing rally to leave a powerful sense of the Gospel in people's hearts and minds.
- 9 Pray for the unity of the church in Meru to continue even after the mission
- 10 As AE Kenya evaluates the Meru Mission and decides on the best way forward, may God give them insight and wisdom in their deliberations.
- 11 Pray for the successful implementation of AE Kenya's 2018–2022 Strategic Plan and for God's continued faithful provision.
- 12 Pray for Benson Omondi, Team Leader of AE Kenya. May he know God's hand in all he does.
- 13 Praise God for AE Kenya's partners who have been working with the team this year!
- 14 Pray for unity among the staff in Kenya and in South Sudan as they work closely.
- 15 Pray for the partner churches of AE Tanzania as they serve the city of Mwanza this week in preparation for the upcoming mission.
- **16** Pray for good health among AE Kenya's staff and their families.

- 17 Pray for the Community Transformation Projects in AE Kenya: the Mathare Women project, the Soweto Kayole Project, and the work in South Sudan.
- **18** Pray for the classes for new converts from the Meru Mission.
- 19 Pray for peace and coexistence of all tribes in Kenya.
- 20 Pray for Loise Kihara, Kenya's Partnership Development Officer. May the Lord keep giving her passion and energy for the work she does!
- **21** Pray that the final preparations for the Mwanza Mission (Tanzania) will come together to ensure a smooth running of events.
- 22 Today is the start of the Tanzania Mwanza Mission! Pray for a successful launch and opening rally. May the Word of God spread through that city.
- 23 Pray for all speakers and evangelists ministering to the people of Mwanza over the next few days. May God's voice speak through them.
- 24 Pray for the president of Kenya, Uhuru Kenyatta. May there be peaceful politics under his rule.
- **25** Pray for the government of Kenya to be free of corruption.
- **26** Pray for the AE Kenya Foxfire team, that through their school ministry, many students will come to the knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 27 Pray there will be transformation in the lives of the Foxfire team, and a change of behaviour and character.
- **28** Pray for rain in Kenya where there has been a three-year drought. May God open the heavens so that people can get food.
- 29 Today is the final day of the Mwanza Mission. Pray that those who have been changed by the Gospel would find joy and strength in their new faith.
- **30 Today is World Day against Trafficking in Persons**. Pray that those in bondage across the world will find freedom!
- **31** Praise God that many are coming to know Christ in Africa.



Spotlight on South Sudan

Join us this month as we lift up South Sudan in prayer. Praise God for the wonderful stories of people being rebuilt as AE works to bring peace and reconciliation to this country ravaged by civil war.

- 1 South Sudan gained independence from Sudan in 2011 after two decades of civil war, the longest in Africa. Pray for the continued recovery of the country.
- 2 Pray for the displaced people of South Sudan those who fled the war and whose homes were destroyed.
- 3 Pray for the Grahamstown Mission taking place in South Africa over the next few days. May the Gospel take hold of people's hearts.
- 4 Pray for the government leadership of South Sudan to be united and for in-fighting to cease so they can focus on rebuilding the country.
- 5 Pray for the 75 young South Sudanese leaders who AE is working with, equipping and empowering them with godly governance and leadership values.
- 6 Pray for the churches in South Sudan to know God's provision and care in the face of overwhelming struggle.
- 7 Pray for AE's efforts to preach the Gospel in Juba, South Sudan's capital, and for success in their peace workshops and leadership training.
- 8 Pray for the AE Kenya team and Stephen Mbogo (CEO) as they head up AE's work in South Sudan.
- 9 With over 60 ethnicities and a history of conflict, tensions are high between the people groups of South Sudan. Pray for unity across Christian circles to be a light to others.
- 10 Pray for the children of South Sudan who have only ever known war May they live to experience Christ's peace.
- 11 Pray for the children and staff at Juba orphanage, where AE has donated food and supplies. Pray for those who have been orphaned or separated from their family during the war.
- 12 Pray for AE's life skills lessons being taught to high school students in Juba. May they be a resource to the teens struggling with the trauma they have experienced.
- 13 Pray for AE's efforts to establish a national prayer breakfast with South Sudan's political leaders. May they find willing partners and open the door to the Gospel.
- 14 Pray for Dr Stephen Mbogo, Janet Mwendwa and others in the AE Kenya team as they work for, travel to and speak with the people of South Sudan.
- 15 Pray for the upcoming Reverse Mission Conference in Abidjan Cote d'Ivoire in June.

- 16 Praise God for the students and ministers who are working with AE to reach North Africa.
- 17 Pray for our partners on the ground in Tunisia, including Pastor Jean, who are diligently working to be a blessing to the nation.
- 18 Pray for those who are participating in the work in Tunisia from Sub-Saharan Africa. Ask God to open their hearts to the need there.
- 19 Pray that the Kenyan University Students who participated in a Reverse Mission workshop in December 2017 will have continued passion for reaching North Africa.
- 20 Today is Pentecost Sunday. Praise God for the gift of the Holy Spirit and pray that more Christians would be open to feel, hear and follow the Spirit!
- 21 Pray for the November event in which Southern Africans will visit Pastor Jean in his church in Tunisia. Pray that Jean would be blessed and feel uplifted in his work.
- 22 Pray for financial provision for our Foxfire ministries in Malawi, Zimbabwe, Kenya, South Africa and Rwanda.
- 23 Pray for more ministry opportunities in schools, colleges, youth conferences, rehabilitation centres and churches for all our Foxfires.
- 24 Pray for health and protection of the five Foxfire teams as they travel through their various countries to reach children and youth for Christ.
- **Today is Africa Day, honouring the founding of the African Union**. Pray that the AU would have wisdom and unity in working for the good of Africa's people. May more Christians join the organisation!
- 26 Pray for the eight young Kenyans recruited in January as this year's Foxfires. May they have courage, commitment and devotion during their year of ministry.
- 27 Today there is a mission prayer rally in Kenya for the July Meru Mission. Let's join our brothers and sisters in Kenya praying for a successful mission!
- 28 Pray for supportive churches and schools to host the Zimbabwe Foxfires as they travel through the country, preaching the Gospel.
- 29 Many of the Foxfires have left their families for this year of ministry. Pray that God would protect their families, and provide for them, especially those from poorer backgrounds.
- 30 Pray for physical and mental strength for the South African Foxfires as much of their Gospel ministry involves drama and dance.
- 31 In South Africa, many schools are not open to Christian groups coming in to preach. Pray for open doors for the Foxfire ministry there!



. Spotlight on Rwanda

Please pray for Rwanda! Pray for its developing economy, for peace between ethnic tribes and for strong leadership. Pray also for AE Rwanda as they labour faithfully in preparation for the Nyarugenge Mission later this month.

- 1 As the AE Rwanda team prepares for the Nyarugenge Mission, pray that the planning and coordination team would follow the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Pray for Mabasi Albert as he works in partnership with Nyarugenge church pastors to coordinate day-to-day schedules, prayer requests and the logistics of the mission.
- 3 Pray for the Rwandan government authorities' continued support of the mission and its activities
- 4 Pray that AE staff will be good ambassadors of Christ throughout this year's mission, and for AE staff to bear fruit within their respective church families
- 5 Pray for God's provision of funds, particularly to cater for ministry to poorer and less-fortunate people during the Nyarugenge Mission.
- 6 Pray that the AE Rwanda staff would have commitment, wisdom and prayerful spirit in all their work.
- 7 Pray that many of Rwanda's students would come to know Christ at the University Mission events taking place in Nyarugenge over the next few days.
- 8 Pray for AE Rwanda's staff to have energy and a spirit of readiness to participate in the Nyarugenge Mission.
- **9** Pray for the active integration of evangelism in all AE projects/programs.
- 10 Today is the start of the Nyarugenge Mission. May the Gospel change lives at each open-air meeting, and each visit to schools, prisons, market places, professionals' fellowships and business centres!
- 11 Jesus called the little children to Him. Pray for a great harvest at the Nyarugenge children's festival today!
- 12 Pray that the women's leaders' conference will be powerful and lifechanging for those who attend.
- 13 Pray for special ministry opportunities to the Muslim population of Rwanda.
- 14 We think of all the speakers and evangelists taking part in this mission. May God speak through them.
- 15 Pray for the Nyarugenge churches to be places of national repentance, reconciliation and healing.
- Pray that the teenagers and young adults at the youth festival in Nyarugenge would commit their lives to Christ today!

- 17 On this final day of the Nyarugenge Mission, pray that the seeds sown in people's hearts over this last week would take root and grow into genuine faith.
- 18 Pray for the nurturing of new believers in Nyarugenge. May they find church communities in which to flourish.
- 19 Pray for God's guidance of the president of Rwanda, Paul Kagame, especially during this year as he serves as Chairman of African Union.
- 20 World Refugee Day. Pray for those across Africa who have had to flee war, oppression and violence. May they find home and provision in God our Father.
- 21 Pray for continued peace in Rwanda, and that the ethnic tension of the past may never repeat itself.
- 22 Pray God's provision for those struggling in the nation, for socioeconomic empowerment, and for improvement in the poorest people's lives.
- 23 Today AE Kenya is conducting missions training for evangelists in the upcoming Meru Mission. Pray for success!
- 24 Pray for the effective and fruitful mobilisation of the missionaries of the Meru Mission.
- 25 Pray for John Kalenzi, Team Leader of AE Rwanda, to have strength and passion in his work.
- 26 Pray for Edward Mungai, John Shikuku and Williams Muchiri on the AE Kenya team as they plan and coordinate the Meru Mission with a team of local Meru pastors.
- 27 Pray for journey mercies for AE Kenya staff as they make several trips in Meru before and during the mission.
- 28 Today is the start of Meru Mission in Kenya. Pray for a great harvest of souls in schools, bars, hotels, business premises, and all over the city!
- 29 Pray that the Meru Mission prayer rally taking place today will draw a great crowd of witnesses.
- **30** Pray for God to show Himself continually to those who have become new Christians in AE's recent missions to Rwanda and Kenya.
