For years, Hatma had been confused by the different messages offered by Islam and Christianity about the true

path to God. Rather than choose one over the other, Hatma, together with a group of his friends, decided that he would respect both religions equally instead. He says:

"I looked at Jesus from the perspective that He was like any other prophet. I got confused as to which faith to follow between Islam and Christianity. Since both religions make reference to Jesus, I considered Him as one of the good prophets. I therefore had a mixture of beliefs. I was neither a Christian nor a Muslim but believed in both. I had many questions about religion and I had never had an opportunity to ask anyone about them."




her in the same spot until the preaching from God's Word began.


"As the sermon was going on, I was feeling fire burning within me. The power of God manifested in me in such a
