# Korogocho Community Hygiene & Sanitation Project and Huye City Mission

The Huye City Rwanda mission will partner with 10 local churches from 12-19 May and will reach university students, prisoners, street children and commercial sex workers. AE's Korogocho Community Hygiene & Sanitation Improvement Project in Kenya provides affordable and environmentally sustainable hygiene solutions in the Korogocho slums.

# **Kenya Mombasa Mission and Ghana Street Children Program**

The Mombasa mission will commence 27 June and aims to reach the two million people of Mombasa over a three year period of mission.

The Ghana Street Children Apprenticeship Project (SCAP) empowers 50 'street' children with skills through vocation courses.

- Pray that the poor and vulnerable households and school children will experience God's love through the Korogocho project and AE staff witness.
- Pray for the resources to meet the huge need for additional toilets for poor households and schools in the slum of Korogocho which are not supported by the government.

- Pray for hearts in Korogocho to be changed forever by the Gospel message of Jesus Christ.
- Pray for the churches in the slums of Nairobi to be witnesses of God's love to His people particularly the poor and vulnerable.
- Pray for opportunities for the Gospel to be effectively proclaimed in the beneficiary households and schools of Korogocho.
- Pray for financial provision for the Huye City mission, that God will move in the hearts of people to give to the work of this ministry!
- Pray for the health and wellbeing of John Kalenzi, Team Leader of Rwanda and his staff members.
- Pray that God will connect the mission team to people in Huye who are waiting to hear about Him—including many members of society who are often neglected.
- Ask God to give the mission team wisdom and direction as new opportunities for ministry become apparent.
- Huye City mission begins today. Pray that the mission team will be bold in proclaiming the Gospel and that many will come to accept the saving work of Jesus Christ.
- Pray for the start of an intensive week of pastor training in Kigali, Rwanda today.
- Pray for AE Rwanda to have wisdom in their ministry and that they will obey the voice of the Holy Spirit.
- Pray for the AE Rwanda staff as they train and equip local believers in Huve to reach others with the Gospel.

- Pray for the leadership of the church in Huye that there will be unity and a resolve to work together for Jesus.
- 17 Pray for believers in Huye to exhibit spiritual maturity and a desire to share their faith.
- Pray for God to give the mission team His power over the darkness evident in Huye city.
- Today is the last day of the Huye City mission. Pray for the continuing work of the Spirit in the lives of those who have heard the Gospel during mission.
- A four day Preaching Conference run by Mike Raiter from Australia starts in Kigali today. Pray that this will equip pastors in handling the Bible for years to come.
- Today is Malawi tripartite elections, pray for fairness and godly leadership as a result of the elections.
- The Korogocho slum is the fourth largest in Kenya, with 250,000 people pressed into 1.5 square km. Pray that AE can provide hope through Christ to the people living in squalid conditions.
- Pray for many families and households struggling with poverty in Korogocho, pray for God's provision.
- Praise God for the positive impact that the building of latrines and handwashing points have provided to the Korogocho community, families and school children.
- Pray that the Lord will give AE wisdom, discernment and best practice in building and servicing an additional 25 latrines and handwashing points in Korogocho this year.
- Pray for the local churches in Korogocho to embrace social action and justice in their ministries so as to preach the Gospel holistically.
- According to World Health Program (WHO, 2013), poor sanitation contributes to about 700,000 child deaths from diarrhoea each year. Please pray that AE initiatives cut child mortality rates.
- Pray for the partnership AE has with our supporters in Australia, NZ and Africa to provide the resources and expertise for building best practice and environmentally friendly ventilated pit latrines.
- Pray for strength, endurance and sustainability for all the pastors and congregations ministering to the people around them in the Kenyan slums.
- Today commences 10 days of global prayer. Praise God for all He is doing in the nation of Africa and for the role that we get to play in the Great Commission through AE.
- Pray for AE in 2019, that God will use this ministry to change the hearts and lives of many in Africa.

### June

- Thank God for the hundreds of lives that has been transformed over the years through the Ghana Street Children Apprenticeship Project (SCAP).
- Pray that God will lead AE in selecting the 50 children for the SCAP this year, according to His will.
- Pray that the children trained in the SCAP will thrive spiritually and economically and that their lives will be transformed forever.
- **Q4** Pray that all the funds needed for the SCAP will be provided (\$41,000 AUD).
- Pray that local churches will be prompted to become partners and take responsibility for the spiritual formation of the children once they have completed the SCAP.
- Pray for successful formation of Community Transformation groups, where beneficiaries of SCAP will meet to grow together spiritually, socially, vocationally and morally.
- Pray for the new leadership and trauma healing workshops and training that AE will conduct in South Sudan.
- Pray for the safety and wellbeing of all AE staff as they travel in and out of troubled zones to provide a witness to Christ's love through Word and Deed.
- Pray for the programs that AE is planning to implement to help transition and empower vulnerable new converts from past lives on the street, prostitution and vice, to new lives in the church.
- Pray for the organisation and effectiveness of the 2,500 stratified evangelism meetings that are envisaged to take place during the upcoming Mombasa mission.
- Pray for the partnering churches in Mombasa, that the Lord will give them unity and harmony while working together in 2019.
- Today is World Day Against Child Labour. Pray for the 218 million children that work across the world, many in hazardous conditions or slavery. Pray for protection and deliverance.
- Pray for the partnering churches in Mombasa, that the Lord will give them unity and harmony while working together in 2019.
- Pray for the various committees that are part of the Mombasa mission, that God will fully equip them for mission.
- Pray for God to open doors for stratified evangelism in Mombasa.

  Pray for God's favour in opening up opportunities to the various strata of society for mission activities.

- Pray for the AE mission team and other AE staff as they are in the preparation phase of mission.
- Pray for the financial provision for the Mombasa mission. Ask God to open up churches, organisations, companies and individuals to give generously towards this mission.
- Pray for protection for the mission team as they minister in Mombasa. Some of the areas in Mombasa are targets and hiding places of terrorists groups.
- Pray for God to provide a vehicle for the Mombasa mission.

  Currently the team uses public transportation which is unreliable.
- Today is World Refugee Day. Pray for God's blessing over the AE refugee program in South Sudan including trauma healing and children's programs and providing food and water to the displaced.
- Mombasa has been regarded as a centre of Islam in Kenya with
   41% of population identifying as Muslim. Pray that God will open their hearts to Christ during the mission.
- Pray for 3,000 mission volunteers for the Mombasa mission that AE will train and equip. Pray that churches from all over the country will send their members to Mombasa.
- Pray that AE will have a powerful effect in training pastors in Mombasa.
- Pray for the various trainings and summits that will be held in preparation for the Mombasa mission.
- Pray for godly leadership for Mombasa. Pray for those who are the key decision makers in the governments, schools, universities and banks.
- Pray for the Mombasa mission team as they prepare to begin mission tomorrow, ask God to equip their hearts for ministry.
- The Mombasa mission begins today, pray that many hearts will be open to the Gospel.
- Christians in Mombasa form 59% of the population, although only 5% attend church. Please pray for spiritual revival.
- Pray for Mombasa mission programs for the 240 schools and 22 higher education institutions whom AE aims to reach through school talks and devotional initiatives.
- Pray for those pastors who recently completed a pastor training course in Malindi that they will hold to the truth faithfully.
