Soweto Kayole Clinic in Kenya is a not-for-profit clinic providing affordable health services to the residents of the surrounding slums.

Three city-wide missions commence this month in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe; Arua, Uganda and Kolwezi, DRC. We aim to reach over 150,000 with the Gospel through these missions.

Zimbabwe Foxfires are AE's youngest evangelists, reaching out to youth in local schools, universities, prisons and streets.
