More about the Project:

While Kenya is generally referred to as a Christian nation, the lack of sound biblical teachings has left many Christians with a very shallow understanding of the core tenets of the Christian faith. Moreover, the widespread emphasis on the prosperity gospel and Christian nominalism necessitates African Enterprise Kenya to undertake this Project which aims at challenging people to follow Jesus Christ as the Lord of their lives.

Project Objectives:

- Effectively proclaim the gospel targeting various demographics in three sub-countries in Nairobi Country.
- Train local community leaders and pastors on discipleship to effectively preserve the new believers during and after the implementation of the Project.
- Provide young believers biblical discipleship materials through local church leaders and project preservation groups.
- Train children and youth ministry leaders with practical skills and biblical materials for effective children and youth ministry.
- Train evangelists with practical digital and marketplace evangelism skills and tools.

In Australia, Simba was an Assistant Minister in an Anglican Church in Perth, a Senior Pastor in Canberra, and Rector at Tatura Anglican Church Victoria. As part of his pastoral roles in Australia,



Simba also held several chaplaincy positions - AFL Goulburn Murray Region, Criminal Justice Chaplain with Anglicare, and Industrial Chaplain for a milk manufacturer.

Simba's leadership of African Enterprise Australasia will flow from his relationship with Jesus and his desire to see many people hear the life-giving message of Jesus. He has a MA (Th) (Perth), PG Cert TE (London), BTh (Windhoek) and is currently a New Testament PhD candidate.
